Mr. Yarnall is the president of the American Canine Association. He has been involved in legislatively protecting dog breeders since the early 1980s' and has testified before many state Senate and House of Representative committee hearings throughout the United States against "anti-breeder" initiatives by animal activist groups.

Texas HB 3180 passed the Texas House of Representatives with a vote of 118 to 31 in the 2009-2010 legislative session. This bill allowed the "animal rights activists" to be the inspectors of your kennel and created burdensome and unfair new regulations for breeders. In essence, it was a bill designed to eliminate all dog breeders from the state of Texas. Texas HB 3180 then moved to the Texas State Senate's Criminal Justice Committee.

The American Canine Association (ACA) quickly sent out Legislative Action Packs to Texas breeders and formed a rally at the Austin Texas Capitol. ACA was able to keep the bill in the committee where it died last session. But this bill and other similar bills are going to be reintroduced in January of 2011.
